## **Trinity**

### **Jesus Christ and His Resurrection**

He offered Himself as a perfect sacrifice for the sins of mankind by dying on a cross, and through the shedding of His blood, atoned for our sins. After three days, Jesus arose from the dead demonstrating his power over sin and death. After His resurrection, Jesus ascended to Heaven's glory to the right hand of the Father and will return again to earth to reign as King of Kings and Lord of Lords.

### **Water Baptism**

## **Communion**

Communion or the Lord's Supper is about remembering what Christ has done for us and the sacrifice He made through His death on the cross to give us salvation and establish a new covenant through the shedding of his blood. This is demonstrated by receiving elements of bread and grape juice, which are symbols of Christ's body and blood. We receive communion monthly during our services.
